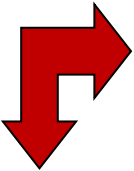

RECREATION FACILITY MANAGEMENT CHART

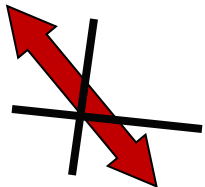

ESTABLISHMENT BYLAW for RC

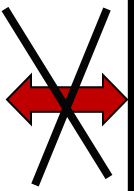


COMMUNITY HALLS
Bouchie Lake Hall and Recreation Grounds
 Cariboo Regional District

REGIONAL DISTRICT (RD)
 Sub-Regional Taxation Function established by RD through Referendum (1980's); RD Taxes collected to support Rural Facilities (x3) & several facilities / trails in City of Quesnel; North Cariboo Joint Planning Committee makes recommendations but no legal authority for decision making; Facility (Buildings / Land) constructed by community but now owned by Regional District (since 1990's); Facility covered under RD Insurance



Recreation Commission
 Purpose is to manage Bouchie Lake Hall & Recreation Grounds, Claymine Trails, and Bouchie-Milburn Community Park
 Established by RD under the Local Government Act
 Community Volunteers appointed by RD on recommendation of Area Director (6-10)
 Area Director member of RC and has a vote; Meets monthly but minimum quarterly
 Members not necessarily Bouchie Lake residents
Mandate is to manage & operate Property, provide security, set fees and set hours of operation, rent the property, manage budget, & pay operational / management costs
 Can support the delivery of some community events (e.g. general community use including but not limited to dinners, dances, and other social gatherings and drop-in activities)
 Rental Revenue, Donations and Fundraising \$ to be retained by RC for its own purposes



Non-Profit Associations
 Bouchie Lake Community Association (Member Funded)
 Friends of Bouchie-Milburn Society (Ordinary)
 Quesnel and District Riding Club (???)
 Bouchie Lake Gymkhana Club (???)
 BLCA (formerly Bouchie Lake Recreation Commission): managed facilities from 1991 – 2007/8)
 Independent registered Non-Profit Associations under Societies Act;
 Boards are elected by the Membership; Operates as per their bylaws
 Non-Profits carry their own General Liability
 No special access to the community facilities (pay rent for Community Access unless approved by BLRC; viewed by BLRC as "renters" (not partners)
