

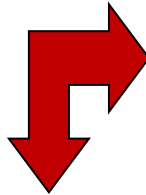

RECREATION FACILITY MANAGEMENT CHART

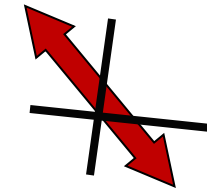

BYLAW for RC**



REGIONAL DISTRICT (RD)
 Sub-Regional Taxation Function established by RD through Referendum (1980's); RD Taxes collected to support Rural Facilities (x3) & several facilities / trails in City of Quesnel; North Cariboo Joint Planning Committee makes recommendations but no legal authority for decision making; Facility (Buildings / Land) constructed by community but now owned by Regional District (since 1990's); Facility covered under RD Insurance



Recreation Commission
 Purpose is to manage Barlow Creek Hall and Ranger Park
 Established by RD under the Local Government Act
 Community Volunteers appointed by RD on recommendation of Area Director;
 Area Director member of RC and has a vote; **Mandate is to manage & operate Property, provide security, set fees and set hours of operation, rent the property, manage budget, & pay operational / management costs**
 Can support the delivery of some community events (e.g. general community use including but not limited to dinners, dances, and other social gatherings and drop-in activities)
 Rental Revenue, Donations and Fundraising \$ to be retained by RC for its own purposes

Non-Profit Society
Barlow Creek Recreation Commission Society
 Works closely with Barlow Creek Recreation Commission (same people / one account); Society carries their own General Liability and Content Insurance (RD does not own contents); Society has full access to the facility at no charge; fundraises and generates funds for the community, the building, and the site
