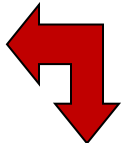
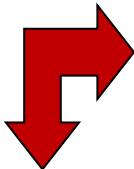
## RECREATION FACILITY MANAGEMENT CHART

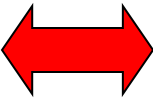
**REGIONAL DISTRICT (RD)**  
Taxation Function established by RD through Referendum; Taxes collected within function by RD to support "Kersley Civic Properties & Recreation Commission" (arena, community hall, and recreation grounds); Facility (Buildings / Land); owned by Regional District; Facility covered under RD Insurance

**ESTABLISHMENT  
BYLAW for CCC**



**Kersley Civic Properties and Recreation Commission**  
Oversees Kerley Recreation with Kersley Community Association  
Makes recommendations to RD for capital improvements and operating requirements  
Established by RD (under Local Government) with a Bylaw (1972 / 1987)  
Community Volunteers (3-9) appointed by RD on recommendation of Area Director; members are property owners of Kersley Service Function;  
Area Director is a Member; Commission meets as required  
Rental funds focused on private functions  
*Commission prepares, for RD, budget for next fiscal year*  
*Daily Operation delivered under contract by a Recreation Manager*

**Community Association**  
Oversees Kersley Recreation Commission  
Makes recommendations to RD for capital improvements and operating requirements  
Independent registered Non-Profit Association under Societies Act ("Ordinary Society"; Board is elected by the Membership; Operates as per CA's bylaw  
CA carries their own General Liability and Content Insurance (RD does not own contents)  
CA has full access to the facility and sets rental rates, access, management structure, etc. (no rent charged)
