REGIONAL DISTRICT (RD)

McLeese Lake Taxation Function established by RD through Referendum (1975); Taxes collected to assist with the maintenance and operation of the recreation facilities (insurance, utilities (hydro and phone), and capital improvements); Contribution Agreement with the McLeese Lake Recreation Commission Society; facility owned by Society (ownership transferred to Society from CRD in 1989; facility – hall, ball park, equestrian grounds (no longer a skating rink))

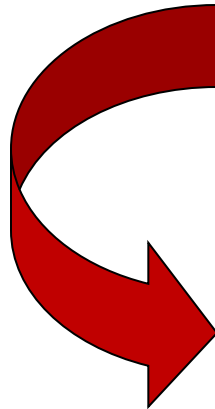


McLeese Lake Recreation Commission Society

Independent registered Non-Profit Association under Societies Act (“Ordinary Society”); Board is elected by the Membership; Operates as per Society’s bylaw; Society carries their own General Liability and Content Insurance; Community residents have full access to the facility at no charge (no rent / no insurance) – funerals, public community events (e.g. volleyball, Mother’s Day Breakfast, Christmas Potluck, etc.); private events are charged rental rates - rental fees allocated to general account (community events, supplies, etc.)
